Charline Ketcherside 1926-2017

Charline served in the Foreign Service of the United States Department of State and was assigned to Berlin and Frankfurt, Germany

After her service, she continued her education at Utah State University, the University of Puerto Rico, and the University of Guadalajara while earning a Master of Arts degree at the University of New Mexico. She moved to California and taught Spanish at Highland Junior High School and San Geronio High School.

After retirement, she served the community as part of many local organizations including;

- Redlands Area Panhellenic Association, President
- Founding member of the Geraldine M. Derkum Scholarship Foundation
- Chair of the Redlands Community Hospital Foundation
- Founding trustee of the Redlands Community Foundation

- Member of Redlands Country Club
- Member of California Women of Agriculture
- Member of Daughters of the American Revolution
- Member of Redlands Republican Women, Federated.

She was named a Woman of Distinction by Town & Gown of the University of Redlands.
